Laboratory



THE CHALLENGE

Pacific Northwest National Laboratory requested a world-class facility suitable for collaborative research and development in earth sciences, data science, energy, the environment, and more. DGR Grant Construction, Inc., a full-service industrial and commercial contractor specializing in government projects, faced with a fixed budget and hard deadline, reached out to Mobile Modular—as they have done in the past—to provide a design build project for PNNL. Working in conjunction, DGR Grant and Mobile Modular arrived at the exact floor plan PNNL wanted, with 70% completion of the modular building in the factory, and critical finishes to be completed on-site.

THE SOLUTION

A total of fifteen modular buildings were set on a permanent foundation to create one 12,000-foot complex that includes a conference room, offices, work spaces, huddle spaces, a kitchenette, bathrooms, and more.

Site preparation was completed at the same time as buildings were being fabricated. Working simultaneously on “two fronts” created a significant time advantage. Including design time, this project took 16 months from start to finish.
